SYNOPSIS

This amendment clarifies that dog houses cannot be constructed entirely of metal. This amendment also clarifies that a dog may not be sheltered in enclosure having only wire flooring. This amendment also clarifies that dogs may be without a leash, but under reasonable control of a competent person, obedient to the person's command, and attended by the dog's owner or custodian in an area permitted by a governmental entity including a municipality.
