# HOUSE BILL NO. 332

# AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 10 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO SHERIFFS.

# BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE:

- 1 Section 1. Amend § 2103, Title 10 of the Delaware Code by making deletions as shown by strike through and
- 2 insertions as shown by underline as follows:
- 3 § 2103. Sheriffs and regular deputies.
- 4 Sheriffs and deputy sheriffs shall <u>do</u> not have any arrest authority. However, sheriffs and deputy sheriffs may take
- 5 into custody and transport a person when specifically so ordered by a judge or commissioner of Superior Court.

# **SYNOPSIS**

This Act removes obsolete language. Sheriffs are not equipped to safely transport prisoners and no sheriff has done so in nearly 10 years. This Act also makes a technical correction to conform existing law to the standards of the Delaware Legislative Drafting Manual.
