HOUSE AMENDMENT NO. 1
TO
SENATE BILL NO. 240

1 AMEND Senate Bill No. 240 on lines 5 through 9 on page 196 by deleting the following:
2 “Upon request from a charter school, the Department of Education will determine the difference between state
3 transportation funding allocations and actual expenditures. If a net savings is demonstrated, the charter school may request
4 to the Secretary of Education, the Director of the Office of Management and Budget, and the Controller General that the
5 savings be used for educational purposes allowable under the state Opportunity Fund.”.

SYNOPSIS

This Amendment removes the ability of a charter school to request that the difference between the amount of the state transportation funding allocation and actual expenditures be used for educational purposes allowed under the state Opportunity Fund.
