## HOUSE BILL NO. 61

## AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 21 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE (Three-fifths of all members elected to each house thereof concurring therein):

#### 1 Section 1. Amend Title 21 of the Delaware Code by making deletions as shown by strike through and insertions

2 as shown by underline as follows:

- 3 § 2140H. Special license plates for Combat Veterans.
- 4 (a)(1) The owner of any vehicle described in subsection (a) (2) of this section may apply to the Department for
- 5 assignment to that vehicle of a special combat veteran registration number; provided, however, that the owner of the vehicle
- 6 must possess and present official documentation which indicates that the owner is a combat veteran.
- 7 (2) This section applies only to the following:
- 8 <u>a. A private passenger vehicle; or</u>
- 9 <u>b.</u> A truck with a 3/4-ton or less manufacturer's rated capacity.
- 10 (b) No fee in addition to the annual registration fee otherwise required by this title is required for registration
- 11 under this section; provided, however, that an original application under this section shall be subject to a \$10 administrative
- 12 fee which shall be deposited into a special fund and used by the Division of Motor Vehicles for the purpose of promoting
- 13 the sale of the plate and administering this section and to fund Department projects notwithstanding the provisions of
- 14 Chapters 13 and 14 of Title 2 to the contrary.
- 15 (c) Only 1 such plate shall be issued to an applicant.
- 16 (d) The Department shall reserve sufficient special license plates including the phrase "COMBAT VETERAN"
- 17 and numbered consecutively beginning with the numeral "1" as are necessary to implement this section.
- 18 (e) Upon receipt by the Department of information that the individual to whom the special plate has been issued
- 19 has died, the Department shall write to the representative of that person's estate, Upon receipt by the Department of
- 20 information that the individual to whom the special plate has been issued has died, the surviving spouse may transfer the
- 21 plate to a vehicle owned by the spouse that meets the requirements of paragraph (a)(2) of this section as a valid registration
- 22 plate. No fee in addition to the annual registration fee otherwise required by this title is required for registration. If no

- 23 spouse exists, the Department shall write to the representative of that person's estate, requesting that such plate be returned
- 24 to the Department within 90 days.

# **SYNOPSIS**

This bill creates a special license plate for Combat Veterans.
