DELAWARE STATE SENATE 151st GENERAL ASSEMBLY

SENATE BILL NO. 45

AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 21 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE (Three-fifths of all members elected to each house thereof concurring therein):

1 Section 1. Amend § 2140, Title 21 of the Delaware Code by making deletions as shown by strike through and

- 2 insertions as shown by underline as follows:
- 3 § 2140. Special registration plates for members of nonprofit organizations.
- 4 (g) At least 200 applications for special plates must be received from a specific organization before the Division of
- 5 Motor Vehicles will approve the issuance. However, the minimum number of 200 shall does not apply to any of the
- 6 following:
- 7 (1) Survivors of Pearl Harbor; Harbor.
- 8 (2) Members of university or high school alumni associations, provided that at least 25 applications for special

9 plates must be received from members of a given university or high school alumni association before the Division of

10 Motor Vehicles will approve the issuance of special plates for that particular university or high school alumni

- 11 association; association.
- 12 (3
 - (3) Retired Delaware police officers; officers.

(4) Members of Delaware Nur Temple and the Service Alumni Association, provided that at least 100
 applications for special plates must be received from members before the Division of Motor Vehicles will approve the
 issuance of the special plate; plate.

- 16 (5) Members of the Marine Corps League and Delaware Veterans of World War 2 Inc. provided that at least
- 100 applications for special plates must be received from members before the Division of Motor Vehicles will approve
 the issuance of the special plate; plate.
- (6) Members of the Order of Eastern Star, Knights of Columbus, the Telephone Pioneers of America, Lions
 Club International_International, and the Senior Olympics, provided that at least 100 applications for special plates
 must be received from members of any of the said organizations before the Director Division of Motor Vehicles will

- approve the issuance of a special plate for that organization, except for the Telephone Pioneers of America who must
 have a minimum of 75 applications for special plates before the <u>Director Division</u> of Motor Vehicles will approve the
 issuance of a special plate for the <u>organization</u>; organization.
- (7) Members of "Fraternal Order of Firemen Wilmington Retired Firefighters," provided that at least 50
 applications for special plates must be received from members of such organization before the Division of Motor
 Vehicles will approve the issuance of the special plate; plate.
- (8) Members of the "USSVI, Mid-Atlantic Base," the U.S. Submarine Veterans, Inc., organization, provided
 that at least 35 applications for special plates be received from members of such organization before the Division of
 Motor Vehicles will approve the issuance of the special plate; and plate.
- 31 (9) Members of the "Buffalo Soldiers Motorcycle Club of Delaware," provided that at least 25 applications
- 32 for special plates must be received from members of such organization before the Division of Motor Vehicles will
- 33 approve the issuance of the special plate.
- 34 (10) Members of "atTAcK addiction," provided that at least 50 applications for special plates must be
- 35 received from members of the organization before the Division of Motor Vehicles will approve the issuance of the
- 36 special plate.

SYNOPSIS

This Act creates a special license plate for members of the nonprofit organization, atTAcK addiction. This Act requires a greater-than-majority vote for passage because Article VIII, § 11 of the Delaware Constitution requires the affirmative vote of 3/5 of the members elected to each house of the General Assembly when a new tax or license fee is imposed.

This Act also makes technical corrections to conform existing law to the standards of the Delaware Legislative Drafting Manual.
