HOUSE BILL NO. 98

AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 4 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE:

- Section 1. Amend § 709, Title 4 of the Delaware Code by making deletions as shown by strike through and insertions as shown by underline as follows:
- § 709 Prohibition of sales <u>and delivery</u> at certain times [Effective until meeting the contingency in 82 Del. Laws,
 c. 193, § 3].
- 5 (a) No entity licensed pursuant to § 501 of this title or importer shall sell or deliver alcoholic liquor on Sundays,
- 6 Thanksgiving, Easter or Christmas or at hours other than those prescribed by the rules or regulations of the Commissioner,
- 7 except as subsection (f) of this section may apply. An importer may receive and process orders on any day, including
- 8 Sundays and holidays.

SYNOPSIS

This Act would allow importers to take orders from retailers any day including Sundays and holidays and process them for delivery.
