HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 12

3 WHEREAS, volunteerism is an essential service that benefits every Delawarean in countless ways; and

4 WHEREAS, volunteers use their own time, money, and energy while putting themselves at greater risk of  
5 contracting COVID-19; and

6 WHEREAS, the services provided by the state and non-profit institutions could not have been achieved without  
7 the assistance of willing volunteers; and

8 WHEREAS, volunteers have ensured that those in economic hardship during the COVID-19 pandemic had access  
9 to food and other needed resources; and

10 WHEREAS, the vaccination efforts that will bring to a close this crisis are heavily reliant on volunteers.
