SENATE AMENDMENT NO. 2
TO
SENATE BILL NO. 63

1 AMEND Senate Bill No. 63 by deleting the enactment clause in its entirety before line 1.

2 FURTHER AMEND Senate Bill No. 63 by inserting the following before line 1:

3 “WHEREAS, in recognition that PFAS chemicals, including aqueous film-forming foam (“AFFF”) used as a fire
4 suppressant, present an emerging challenge with much yet to be learned about their negative effect on public health and the
5 environment, this Act serves as an initial step towards reducing the use and, where used, containment of PFAS chemicals in
6 firefighting applications, while encouraging the use of available safer alternatives, despite their additional cost and
7 decreased effectiveness; and

8 WHEREAS, this Act is not intended to convey approval of the use of PFAS chemicals or the continued use of
9 AFFF in firefighting applications, except in limited circumstances under this Act, for training, testing, and emergency use.

10 NOW, THEREFORE:

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE:”.
