#### HOUSE BILL NO. 154

# AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 19 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO DISCRIMINATION IN EMPLOYMENT.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE:

1 Section 1. Amend § 711, Title 19 of the Delaware Code by making deletions as shown by strike through and

- 2 insertions as shown by underline as follows:
- 3 § 711. Unlawful employment practices; employer practices.
- 4 (q) Nothing in this subchapter shall affect the ability of an employer to require employees to adhere to reasonable

5 workplace appearance, grooming and dress standards not precluded by other provisions of state or federal law, except that

- 6 an employer shall allow an employee to appear, groom and dress consistent with the employee's gender identity.
- 7 (r) It shall be an unlawful employment practice for an employer to:
- 8 (1) Fail or refuse to hire or to discharge any individual or otherwise discriminate against any individual
   9 with respect to compensation, terms, conditions, or privileges of employment because of such individual's political
- 10 <u>affiliation or political belief.</u>
- 11 (2) Limit, segregate, or classify employees in any way which would deprive or tend to deprive any
- 12 individual of employment opportunities or otherwise adversely affect the individual's status as an employee
- 13 because of such individual's political affiliation or political belief.
- 14 (3) Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraphs (1) and (2) of this subsection, it shall not be an unlawful
- 15 employment practice if the employer can demonstrate that political affiliation or political belief is a bona fide
- 16 <u>occupational qualification for the position that such individual holds or desires, or is required by law, or is</u>
- 17 reasonably necessary to the normal operation of that particular business or enterprise.
- 18 Section 2. Amend § 710, Title 19 of the Delaware Code by making deletions as shown by strike through and
  19 insertions as shown by underline as follows:
- 20 § 710. Definitions.
- 21 For the purposes of this subchapter:

- 22 () "Political affiliation" means membership of or close association with a political party or organization.
- 23 () "Political belief" means a person's own value judgment of what is or what should be concerning the body
- 24 politic, including stances on individual issues concerning the body politic.

## **SYNOPSIS**

This Act makes it an unlawful employment practice for an employer to discriminate against any individual because of their political affiliation or political belief.
