SENATE BILL NO. 125

AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 14 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE:

1 Section 1. Amend Title 14 of the Delaware Code, by making deletions as shown by strike through and insertions  
2 as shown by underline as follows:

3 § 8401. Tuition and fees for spouses and children of active duty military.

4 Notwithstanding any other provision of this code, the spouse and any child of a member of the active military  
5 service of the United States, who has been assigned to duty elsewhere immediately following assignment to duty in  
6 Delaware, shall be deemed to be an in-state resident for the purposes of determining tuition, fees, and other charges at  
7 Delaware public universities, colleges, or community colleges, and is entitled to pay the tuition, fees and other charges  
8 imposed upon Delaware residents as long as the spouse or child remains enrolled at such institution.

SYNOPSIS

This bill provides that the spouse and any child of a member of the active military service of the United States, who has been assigned to duty elsewhere immediately following assignment to duty in Delaware, shall be deemed to be an in-state resident for the purposes of determining the tuition, fees, and other charges at Delaware public universities, colleges, or community colleges as long as the spouse or child remains enrolled at such institution.
