SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 59

CONGRATULATING THE CLASS OF 2019-2020 EAGLE SCOUTS FOR HAVING ATTAINED THE HIGHEST
RANK ONE CAN EARN IN THE BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA.
