SENATE BILL NO. 207

AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 21 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO TRUCK WEIGHTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE:

1 Section 1. Amend § 2105, Title 21 of the Delaware Code by making deletions as shown by strike through and
2 insertions as shown by underline as follows:

3 § 2105. Registration of heavy vehicles.

4 (d) Any vehicle which has a gross weight in excess of 26,000 pounds, except as provided in §§ 2152 and
5 4502(c)(2) of this title, shall not be registered at a weight in excess of the manufacturer's gross vehicle weight for such
6 vehicle or the Federal Bridge Formula in the absence of a manufacturer's gross vehicle weight rating. For those vehicles
7 registered pursuant to § 2152 of this title, the actual gross weight of the vehicle, or each vehicle in combination, shall not
8 exceed the manufacturer's gross vehicle weight rating. For those vehicles registered for extra weight capacity pursuant to
9 the exception of § 4502(c)(2) of this title, the following shall apply:

10 (1) Vehicles registering for such extra weight capacity shall pay a fee of \$100 per vehicle at the time of
11 registration;

12 (2) No vehicle with a manufacturer's gross vehicle weight rating of less than 65,000 shall be registered at a
13 weight in excess of the manufacturer's gross vehicle weight rating for such vehicle;

14 (3) No vehicle being registered for the first time shall be registered at a weight in excess of the manufacturer's
15 gross vehicle weight rating for such vehicle;

16 (4) No vehicle with a model year 20 or more years prior to the date of registration shall be registered at a
17 weight in excess of the manufacturer's gross vehicle weight rating for such vehicle; and

18 (5) Commencing June 15, ~~2022~~ 2026, no vehicle shall be registered at a weight in excess of the
19 manufacturer's gross vehicle weight rating for such vehicle.

SYNOPSIS

This Act extends until 2026 the requirement that agriculture and intrastate construction vehicles be registered in accordance with the manufacturer's gross vehicle weight rating.
