DELAWARE STATE SENATE 151st GENERAL ASSEMBLY

SENATE BILL NO. 229

AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 18 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO RESIDENT INSURANCE PRODUCER LICENSURE REOUIREMENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE:

1 Section 1. Amend Section 1706, Title 18, of the Delaware Code by making deletions as shown by strike through 2 and insertions as shown by underline as follows: 3 § 1706. Application for license. 4 (a) A person applying for a resident license shall make application to the Insurance Commissioner on the Uniform 5 Application or on forms prescribed by the Commissioner for license types and lines of authority not available on the 6 Uniform Application and declare under penalty of refusal, suspension or revocation of the license that the statements made 7 in the application are true, correct and complete to the best of the individual's knowledge and belief. Before approving the 8 application, the Insurance Commissioner shall find that the individual: 9 (1) Is at least 18 years of age; 10 (2) Has not committed any act that is a ground for denial, suspension, or revocation set forth in § 1712 of this title; (3) Has paid the fees set forth in Chapter 7 of this title; and 11 12 (4) Has successfully passed the examinations for the lines of authority for which the person has applied, unless 13 specifically exempted from such examination by this chapter; and 14 (5) If applying for a resident producer license, is a resident of Delaware or works for a business entity that is licensed to conduct the business of insurance in Delaware and maintains a physical location in Delaware that is 15 16 open to the public and from which such business is conducted. An applicant may not use registered agent services 17 or a Delaware postal box in order to establish the residency requirements set forth in this paragraph. 18 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon enactment and shall apply to new applicants applying for a 19 Delaware resident producer license.

SYNOPSIS

This bill requires applicants for a Delaware resident producer license to either be a Delaware resident or to work for an entity that has a physical location in Delaware out of which the business of insurance is conducted. This bill prohibits the practice of out-of-state applicants using Delaware registered agents or postal boxes to establish residency in Delaware. These changes will help to reduce or eliminate the improper marketing of insurance plans by bad actors that seek to avoid regulatory oversight through these licensing practices.
