SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 80

RECOGNIZING MARCH 29, 2022 AS "NATIONAL VIETNAM WAR VETERANS DAY" IN THE STATE OF DELAWARE.

1	WHEREAS, National	Vietnam War	Veterans Day	v is to honor	and thank ou	r Nation's V	Vietnam veterai	ns and their

- 2 families for their service and sacrifice; and
- 3 WHEREAS, this day also aims to highlight the service of the Armed Forces and support organizations during the

4 war, pay tribute to wartime contributions at home by American citizens, highlight technology, science and medical

5 advances made during the war, and recognize contributions by our Allies; and

- 6 WHEREAS, about 9.2 million Americans served between November 1, 1955 and May 15, 1975; and
- 7 WHEREAS, there are 58,318 names memorialized on the Vietnam Veterans Memorial wall in our Nation's
- 8 capital; and
- 9 WHEREAS, at least 304,000 of those who served were wounded during their service; and
- 10 WHEREAS, 1,244 of those who served are Missing in Action and have not returned home; and
- 11 WHEREAS, there were about 2,500 Prisoners of War during this time; and
- 12 WHEREAS, about 2.8 million of those who served were exposed to the poisonous chemical, Agent Orange, with
- 13 many still affected by this exposure; and
- 14 WHEREAS, March 29th was chosen as the date of recognition and thanks because March 29, 1973 was the day
- 15 Military Assistance Command Vietnam was deactivated.
- 16 NOW, THEREFORE:
- 17 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the 151st General Assembly of the State of Delaware, the House concurring
- 18 therein, that March 29, 2022 is hereby recognized as "National Vietnam War Veterans Day" in the State of Delaware.
