HOUSE BILL NO. 295
AS AMENDED BY
HOUSE AMENDMENT NO. 1

AN ACT TO AMEND TITLES 21 AND 29 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO A DESIGNATED PARKING SPACE FOR VETERANS AT STATE BUILDINGS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE:

Section 1. Amend § 4179, Title 21 of the Delaware Code by making deletions as shown by strike through and insertions as shown by underline as follows:

§ 4179. Stopping, ~~standing~~ standing, or parking.

(e) No person ~~shall~~ may stop, ~~stand~~ stand, or park a vehicle, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a police officer or traffic-control device, including all state-owned ~~and/or~~ and state leased property; in any of the following places:

(19) In any area owned by, leased by or under the control of the State, when such area has been designated by the Director of the Office of Management and Budget as a reserved parking space for members of the General Assembly, their staff, state-owned vehicles, specific state ~~offices~~ offices, or state ~~employees~~ employees, unless the person is the person or in the class of persons for whom the parking space is reserved. Such parking spaces will be conspicuously marked as such;

(20) In any area designated by the Director of the Office of Management and Budget as a reserved parking space under § 6309A of Title 29, unless the person is the person or in the class of persons for whom the parking space is reserved;

(21) In any areas area which in any manner restricts access to or ingress or egress from the areas defined in paragraph (19) or (20) of this subsection.

(i) A violation of paragraph 20 or 21, with respect to paragraph 20, of this subsection is not subject to a civil penalty under § 4178 of this title.

Section 2. Amend § 6309A, Title 29 of the Delaware Code by making deletions as shown by strike through and insertions as shown by underline as follows:

§ 6309A. ~~Human Resources Management [Repealed];~~ Designated Parking Space.

The Director of the Office of Management and Budget must designate 1 or more reserved parking spaces for a veteran as defined in § 8811 of this title at the following State-owned locations or a successor location that serves the same function. For the following facilities leased by the State or a successor location that serves the same function, the Director is encouraged to work with the lessor to designate 1 or more reserved parking spaces for a veteran as defined in § 8811 of this title.

- (1) Delaware City Division of Motor Vehicles.
- (2) Greater Wilmington Division of Motor Vehicles.
- (3) Dover Division of Motor Vehicles.
- (4) Georgetown Division of Motor Vehicles.
- (5) Appoquinimink State Service Center.
- (6) Belvedere State Service Center.
- (7) Claymont State Service Center.
- (8) DeLaWarr State Service Center.
- (9) Floyd I. Hudson State Service Center.
- (10) Northeast State Service Center.
- (11) Winder Laird Porter State Service Center.
- (12) Division of Social Services' Canby Park Office.
- (13) Churchman's Corporate Center.
- (14) Robscott Building.
- (15) James W. Williams State Service Center.
- (16) Blue Hen Corporate Center.
- (17) Smyrna State Service Center.
- (18) Bridgeville State Service Center.
- (19) Edward W. Pyle State Service Center.
- (20) Laurel State Service Center.
- (21) Milford State Services Center Campus.
- (22) Thurman Adams State Service Center.
- (23) Anna C. Shipley State Service Center.

Section 3. The Director of the Office of Management and Budget is encouraged to consider the designation of reserved parking spaces for a veteran as defined in § 8811 of this title at future State-owned and leased facilities where feasible.

Section 4. This Act takes effect 6 months after its enactment into law.
