SENATE AMENDMENT NO. 2
TO
HOUSE BILL NO. 165

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE:

1 AMEND House Bill No. 165 by deleting in the enactment clause after "DELAWARE" and before the colon the
2 following: "(Three-fifths of all members elected to each house thereof concurring therein)".

3 FURTHER AMEND House Bill No. 165 on line 48 by after "(2)" by deleting "A \$100 application fee." as it
4 appears therein and inserting in lieu thereof "An application fee determined by the Commissioner. The amount of the fee
5 must approximate and reasonably reflect the costs necessary to defray the expenses of the Commissioner's service and
6 activities in connection with this section.".

7 FURTHER AMEND House Bill No. 165 on line 50 by deleting "\$100" between "Commissioner" and "biennially"
8 as it appears therein.

9 FURTHER AMEND House Bill No. 165 on line 51 by deleting "\$1,000 biennially" between "or" and "to" as it
10 appears therein.

11 FURTHER AMEND House Bill No. 165 on line 107 by deleting "and pay an application fee of \$100" after
12 "permit" as it appears therein.

13 FURTHER AMEND House Bill No. 165 on line 113 by deleting "paying a \$100 renewal fee and" between "by"
14 and "providing" as it appears therein.

SYNOPSIS

This Amendment removes the new fees from House Bill No. 165, reducing the vote requirement to a simple majority. Current law provides for a direct shipper license and the fee for this license is determined by the Commissioner. With this Amendment, instead of creating a \$100 fee for a wine direct shipper license in § 526(b) and (c) of Title 4, the existing fee for a direct shipper license in § 526(b) is retained. In addition to not creating a new fee, House Bill No. 165 narrows the direct shipper license from permitting the shipment of wine and beer to just wine.
