HOUSE BILL NO. 435

AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 24 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO THE SECURITY SYSTEMS AND PROTECTIVE SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE:

Section 1. Amend § 1209, Title 24 of the Delaware Code, by striking subsection (a) thereof in its entirety an by substituting in lieu thereof the following:

"(a) Identification cards approved by the Superintendent shall expire and be renewable on the 5th anniversary date of the birth of the applicant next following the date of its issuance unless the birth date is February 29, in which event the license shall expire and be renewable on February 28 every 5th year."

SYNOPSIS

This Act allows identification cards issued to licensed persons working in the security systems industry to be valid for 5 years instead of 1 year and arranges the renewal dates by the licensee's birthdate.
