HOUSE BILL NO. 434

AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 24 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO THE PRIVATE INVESTIGATORS  
AND PRIVATE SECURITY AGENCIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE:

- 1           Section 1. Amend § 1324, Title 24 of the Delaware Code, by striking the language thereof in its entirety the and  
2 by substituting in lieu thereof the following:
- 3           "Anyone required to be licensed under this chapter shall be issued, by the Board of Examiners, an  
4 identification card which shall expire and be renewable on the 5<sup>th</sup> anniversary date of the birth of the applicant  
5 next following the date of its issuance unless the birth date is February 29, in which event the license shall expire  
6 and be renewable on February 28 every 5<sup>th</sup> year."

SYNOPSIS

This Act allows identification cards issued to licensed persons working in the private investigator and private security industry to be valid for 5 years instead of 2 years and arranges the renewal dates by the licensee's birthdate.
