SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO.

HONORING THE YOUNG WOMEN FROM ACROSS THE STATE OF DELAWARE PARTICIPATING IN THE 2001 SESSION OF DELAWARE'S GIRLS' STATE.

1	WHEREAS, during the week of June 19, 2001, 72 young women from across the State of Delaware, students at
2	the state's public and private high schools, have come to Legislative Hall in Dover to participate in the 2001 session of
3	Delaware Girls' State; and
4	WHEREAS, during their stay here, these young women will be receiving valuable hands-on training and
5	experience in the legislative process and the ways of state government, which will serve them in good stead in their later
6	lives; and
7	WHEREAS, the experience they are receiving during Girls' State will prove especially useful to those among their
8	number who go on to assume leadership roles in government or seek elective office in the future; and
9	WHEREAS, the participants in Delaware Girls' State have, during their session, elected from among their ranks
10	a Governor, a Lieutenant Governor, a State Treasurer, a State Auditor, a State Insurance Commissioner and members of
11	both houses of the General Assembly; and

93	program, as they have done for many years, thereby displaying a deep dedication to the American system of government	
94	and to the essential task of ensuring that our youth understand and appreciate that system.
