### HOUSE BILL NO. 480

## AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 16 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO AMBULANCE ATTENDANTS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE:

- 1 Section 1. Amend §6712(c), Title 16 of the Delaware Code by designating the existing subsection (c) as subparagraph
- 2 (1) and adding a new subparagraph (2) to read as follows:
- 3 "The Commission may extend the suspension of an ambulance attendant or emergency medical technician's
- 4 certification for a period not to exceed 30 days, if the Commission reviews the charges supporting the suspension of
- 5 an ambulance attendant by an Emergency Medical Services Medical Director pursuant to §9806(b)(7) of this Title and
- 6 concludes that a Commission hearing should be scheduled to consider the charges."
- 7 Section 2. Amend §6610(a), Title 16 of the Delaware Code by inserting the phrase ", or in exercise of its authority
- 8 decertifying or suspending the Certificate of an ambulance attendant or emergency medical technician (EMT) under
- 9 §6712(c)(1) of this Title," after the word "title" in the first sentence.

#### **SYNOPSIS**

This bill allows the State Fire Prevention Commission to extend the suspension of an ambulance attendant or EMT's certification to allow for a hearing, when that ambulance attendant or EMT was initially suspended by an Emergency Medical Services Medical Director. The Act also allows for Judicial Review of a decision by the Commission to suspend a certificate when the ambulance attendant or EMT no longer meets qualifications.
