SENATE AMENDMENT NO. 1

TO

SENATE BILL NO. 60

1 AMEND Senate Bill No. 60 by deleting lines 18 through 21, and replace them with the following:

2 “(b) Any person who intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly (i) makes any false statement, representation or  
3 certification in any application, record, report, plan or other document filed or required to be maintained under this  
4 chapter, or under any permit, rule, regulation or order issued under this chapter, or (ii) who falsifies, tampers with, or  
5 renders inaccurate any monitoring device or method required to be maintained under this”.

6 FURTHER AMEND Senate Bill No. 60 by deleting lines 30 through 31, and replace them with the following:

7 “one result of such conduct, shall be guilty of a Class D felony and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced in  
8 compliance with the sentencing guidelines established for Class D felonies in 11 Del.C. § 4205.”

9 FURTHER AMEND Senate Bill No. 60 by deleting lines 38 through 39, and replacing them with the following:

10 “such conduct, shall be guilty of a Class D felony and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced in compliance with  
11 the sentencing guidelines established for Class D felonies in 11 Del.C. § 4205.”

12 FURTHER AMEND Senate Bill No. 60 by deleting lines 48 through 49 and replacing them with the following:

13 “such an act, the officer, manager, or general partner committing the act shall be guilty of a Class D felony and  
14 shall, upon conviction, be sentenced in compliance with the sentencing guidelines established for Class D felonies in 11  
15 Del.C. § 4205. Nothing in this”

16 FURTHER AMEND Senate Bill No. 60 by deleting line 66 and replace it with the following:

17 “persons within the State of Delaware.”
