SENATE BILL NO. 98

AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 11 OF THE DELAWARE CODE WITH RESPECT TO PARTICIPATION IN VIOLENT GANGS.

1	WHEREAS, law enforcement authorities have noted an increase in the number of criminal street gangs with				
2	active presences in the State of Delaware; and				
3	WHEREAS, Delaware needs the tools to deter active participation in illegal activities conducted by criminal				
4	street gangs; and				
5	WHEREAS, such legislation must be carefully tailored to ensure that it punishes illegal activities while				
6	protecting Delawareans' constitutional rights;				
7	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE:				
8	Section 1. Amend Title 11 of the Delaware Code, by adding a new Section 616, to read as follows:				
9	"§ 616. Gang Participation.				
10	(a) Definitions. The following terms shall have the following meaning as used in this Section.				
11	(1) 'Criminal street gang' means any ongoing organization, association, or group of				
12	three or more persons, whether formal or informal, having as one of its primary				
13	activities the commission of one or more of the criminal acts enumerated in				
14	subsection (a)(2) of this Section, having a common name or common identifying				
15	sign or symbol, and whose members individually or collectively engage in or have				
16	engaged in a pattern of criminal gang activity.				
17	(2) 'Pattern of criminal gang activity' means the commission of, attempted commission of, conspiracy				
18	to commit, solicitation of, or conviction of two or more of the following criminal offenses, provided Page 1 of 3

19		that at	least one of these offenses occurred after July 1, 2003 and that the last of those offenses
20		occurr	ed within three years after a prior offense, and provided that the offenses were committed on
21		separa	te occasions, or by two or more persons:
22		(i) A	ssault, as defined in Sections 612 or 613 of this Title.
23		(ii) A	ny criminal acts causing death as defined in Sections 632 through 636 of this Title.
24		(iii) A	ny criminal acts relating to sexual offenses defined in Sections 768 through 780 of this Title.
25		(iv) A	ny criminal offenses relating to unlawful imprisonment or kidnapping which are defined in
26		Se	ections 782 through 783A of this Title.
27			ny criminal acts of arson as defined in Sections 801 through 803 of this Title.

30		(vii) A	ny criminal acts relating to robbery which are defined in Sections 831 through 832 of this

47	(1)	Any person who is convicted of a Class E felony committed for the benefit of, at the direction of, or
48		in association with any criminal street gang, with the specific intent to promote, further, or assist in
49		any criminal conduct by gang members, shall, upon conviction of that felony, be sentenced
50		consistent with the sentence dictated by Delaware law for a Class D felony under 11 Del.C. §
51		4205(b)(4).
52	(2)	Any person who is convicted of a Class D felony committed for the benefit of, at the direction of,
53		or in association with any criminal street gang, with the specific intent to promote, further, or assist
54		in any criminal conduct by gang members, shall, upon conviction of that felony, be sentenced
55		consistent with the sentence dictated by Delaware law for a Class C felony under 11 Del.C. §
56		4205(b)(3).
57	(3)	Any person who is convicted of a Class C felony committed for the benefit of, at the direction of, or
58		in association with any criminal street gang, with the specific intent to promote, further, or assist in
59		any criminal conduct by gang members, shall, upon conviction of that felony, be sentenced
60		consistent with the sentence dictated by Delaware law for a Class B felony under 11 Del.C. §
61		4205(b)(2)."

SYNOPSIS

This Bill creates a new Class F felony for active participation in a violent street gang, when that participation assists the gang in furthering activity which would constitute a felony under Delaware law. It also creates sentencing enhancements for other felonies committed in the course of active gang participation.
