BILL:	HOUSE BILL NO. 161
SPONSOR:	Representative Ramone
DESCRIPTION:	AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 7 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO CONSERVATION.

Assumptions:

1. This Act become effective upon the signature of the Governor.
2. This Act will expand the list of fishing license exemptions to include residents of long term care facilities who are accompanied by the facility's controlling person. The exemption currently includes persons who are patients in any Veterans Administration facility, public hospital, sanitarium, or rehabilitation hospital under the State Department of Health.
3. A resident fishing license in Delaware costs \$11.00.
4. The revenues generated from the sale of annual fishing licenses are Appropriated Special Funds (ASF). License revenues are dedicated to wildlife and fisheries conservation, administration of the hunting and fishing licensing program, and earmarked to secure matching funds allotted to Delaware by the U.S. Department of the Interior, Fish and Wildlife Service.
