BILL: HOUSE BILL NO. 431 AS AMENDED

SPONSOR: Representative Spence

DESCRIPTION: AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 4, DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO UNDERAGE

DRINKING, IDENTIFICATION AND PENALTIES.

ASSUMPTIONS:

1. Effective 6 months after enactment.

- The Act requires that businesses licensed as taprooms and those licensed as restaurants selling alcohol for consumption off of the premises install and maintain Electronic Identification Verification equipment.
- The Act as amended provides for a tax credit for the purchase of the required Electronic
 Identification Verification equipment of 100% of cost of purchase against any tax spread over four
 tax years.
- 4. The revenue loss estimate is based on the following assumptions:
 - a) An average cost of \$700 to \$1,000 per machine;
 - b) 400 businesses required to purchase machines;
 - c) A uniform 6 month lag between enactment and machine purchase.
