AN ACT MAKING A ONE-TIME SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2021 TO THE OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE:

Section 2. Section 1 of this Act makes an appropriation to the Department of Health and Social Services, Social Services (35-07-01) of \$100,000 for Group Violence Intervention Services. It is the intent of the Administration and the General Assembly that these funds shall be used for implementation of evidence-based and evidence-informed programming that reduces urban shootings and homicides. The Division of Social Services shall develop application requirements and procedures for administering funds and shall submit a report to the Director of the Office of Management and Budget and the Controller General no later than October 15th of each fiscal year detailing the plan for the expenditure of these funds.

SYNOPSIS

This Act appropriates \$9,894,300 to provide one-time funded projects through the Office of Management and Budget.
