DIRECTING THE STATE VETERINARIAN TO INVESTIGATE USES OF CHEMICAL TREATED SALT LICKS TO CONTROL THE DEER POPULATION.

- WHEREAS, current regulations have been unable to control the deer population; and
 WHEREAS, an uncontrolled deer population is dangerous to public health and the environment, especially agricultural
 crops; and
 WHEREAS, there are potential methods which could control deer population that are non-lethal.
 NOW, THEREFORE:
- BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 143rd General Assembly of the State of Delaware that the State
- 7 Veterinarian is directed to investigate the feasibility of chemical treated salt licks in order to prevent deer reproduction.
