DESCRIPTION: AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 29 OF THE DELAWARE CODE ESTABLISHING THE

OFFICE OF THE STATE INSPECTOR GENERAL.

ASSUMPTIONS:

1. Effective 180 days after signed into law; however, the fiscal impact shall commence on July 1, 2007.

- 2. This Act establishes the Office of the State Inspector General to investigate State employees and State agencies for waste, fraud abuse and corruption. This Office shall make reports to the Governor and refer and report findings for possible prosecution to the Attorney General.
