AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 14 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO THE INSPIRE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM.

Assumptions:

- 1. This Act becomes effective upon signature by the Governor.
- 2. This Act changes the Inspire scholarship grant award calculation to be equal to the full in-state tuition rate at Delaware State University.
- 3. Currently, Inspire recipient grants are limited to be equal to what would be received by a similar Student Excellence Equals Degree (SEED) scholarship recipient. Inspire grants are renewable, but the entire grant amount over a recipient's education cannot exceed the total amount of a SEED grant over a SEED recipient's education.
- 4. The full in-state tuition rate for Delaware State University (DSU) is \$7,038 per year. The average annual SEED award is approximately \$3,600. Upon enactment, this bill will result in an average increased Inspire award amount of \$3,438 annually per student.
- 5. There are 680 students currently receiving Inspire grants. DSU estimates this amount will increase to 796 students in Fiscal Year 2022.
- 6. Costs are assumed to increase at a rate of 3% to reflect enrollment growth.
