

151st GENERAL ASSEMBLY FISCAL NOTE

BILL: HOUSE BILL NO. 128

SPONSOR: Representative Griffith

DESCRIPTION: AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 14 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO

EXCEPTIONAL CHILDREN.

Assumptions:

1. This Act becomes effective upon signature by the Governor.

- 2. This Act extends special education and related services through the 2021-2022 school year for students with a disability who turn 21 during the 2020-2021 school year to address unfinished learning caused by the COVID-19 pandemic.
- 3. This Act requires the Individualized Education Program (IEP) team to review and revise each affected student's IEP to enumerate the specific basis for extension of services provided.
- 4. Per the Delaware Department of Education, there are 110 students who will be eligible for services under this Act.
- 5. If all eligible students elect to utilize the services under this Act, an estimated 19.41 additional funding units will be generated for the 2021-2022 school year.
- 6. The estimated state cost per unit generated by this Act is \$97,657 (includes Division I, II, and III units), and the estimated local cost per unit is \$25,105.
