

151st GENERAL ASSEMBLY FISCAL NOTE

BILL:	HOUSE BILL NO. 213
SPONSOR:	Representative Mitchell
DESCRIPTION:	AN ACT TO AMEND THE CHARTER OF THE TOWN OF ELSMERE AND TITLE 21 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO A VOLUNTARY ASSESSMENT CENTER.

Assumptions:

- 1. This Act takes effect upon the signature of the Governor.
- 2. This Act provides the Town of Elsmere (Elsmere) with the authorization to create a Voluntary Assessment Center (VAC) and establishes procedures governing the creation and operation of the VAC.
- 3. Presently, cases handled through voluntary assessment mail-in or online payment procedures carry court costs of \$20.00.
- 4. Establishing a VAC within the boundaries of Elsmere would result in a general fund (GF) revenue loss to the State as the court costs associated with each voluntary assessment issued by Elsmere Police Department (EPD) would instead be collected by Elsmere.
- 5. In 2019, EPD issued approximately 3,221 charges, resulting in a collection of \$64,420. It is estimated that the revenue loss associated with this Act would be around \$65,000 annually.
