DESCRIPTION:	AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 7 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO

In accordance with 29 Del. C. §913, the following information is provided relating to licenses and fees.

Description of the Legislation:

This Act as amended provides the option of a lifetime conservation access pass for \$65 for Delaware residents, 65 years of age or older.

Affected Entities:

The affected entities of this Act are the Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control and Delaware residents, 65 years of age or older.

Fiscal Impact:

The Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control is unable to determine how many seniors age 65 or older will purchase this pass or replace their annual pass with the new lifetime pass. Because this data is unavailable, the total revenues generated by this Act are indeterminable.

Intended Use of Revenue:

Revenues generated from the sale of annual conservation access passes are Appropriated Special Funds (ASF). Conservation access pass revenues are dedicated to the Division of Fish and Wildlife for maintenance and improvement of public access, facilities, and wildlife habitat on State Wildlife Areas.
