# AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 21 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO RULES OF THE ROAD.

Section 1. Amend Title 21 of the Delaware Code by adding a new §4176C to read as follows:

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE:

2	"§ 4176C. Electronic communication devices; penalties.
3	(a) No driver shall operate a motor vehicle on any highway while using an electronic communication device while
4	such vehicle is in motion.
5	(b) For the purposes of this section, the following terms shall mean:
6	(1) 'cell telephone' shall mean a cellular, analog, wireless or digital telephone.
7	(2) 'electronic communication device' shall mean a cell phone, personal digital assistant, electronic
8	device with mobile data access, laptop computer, pager, broadband personal communication device, two-way
9	messaging device, electronic game, or portable computing device.
10	(3) 'hands-free electronic communication device' shall mean an electronic communication device that has
1	an internal feature or function, or that is equipped with an attachment or addition, whether or not permanently part
12	of such electronic communication device, by which a user engages in a call without the use of either or both hand.
13	(4) 'hands-free equipment' shall mean the internal feature or function of a hands-free electronic
14	communication device or the attachment or addition to a hands-free electronic communication device by which a
15	user may engage in a call without the use of either or both hand.
16	(5) 'engages or engaging in a call' shall mean when a person dials or punches a phone number on, talks
17	into or listens on an electronic communication device.
18	(6) 'using' shall mean holding an electronic communication device while:
19	a. Viewing or transmitting images or data;

20	b. Playing games;
21	c. Composing, sending, reading, viewing, accessing, browsing, transmitting, saving or retrieving
22	e-mail, text messages or other electronic data; or
23	d. Engaging in a call.
24	(c) Subsection (a) of this section shall not apply to:
25	(1) a law-enforcement officer, a firefighter, an emergency medical technician, a paramedic or the operato
26	of an authorized emergency vehicle in the performance of their official duties;
27	(2) a person using an electronic communication device to report to appropriate authorities a fire, a traffic
28	accident, a serious road hazard, or medical or hazardous materials emergency, or to report the operator of another
29	motor vehicle who is driving in a reckless, careless or otherwise unsafe manner or who appears to be driving unde
30	the influence of alcohol or drugs or any other crime.
31	(3) a person using a cell phone who is operating a school bus and covered under §4176B of this title;
32	(4) a person using a hands-free electronic communication device and its hand-free equipment when such
33	person engages in a call; and
34	(5) the activation or deactivation of hands-free equipment or a function of hands-free equipment.
35	(d) Whoever violates this section shall for the 1st offense be subject to a civil penalty of \$50. For each subsequen
36	offense the person shall be subject to a civil penalty of not less than \$100 nor more than \$200.
37	(e) No motor vehicle points shall be assessed for a violation of this section. Additionally, a violation of this
38	section shall not be made a part of a person's driving record.".
39	Section 2. The provisions of this Act shall preempt the provisions of a municipal or county enactment regulating
40	the use of any electronic communication device by a person operating a vehicle as defined in §101 (80) of this title.
41	Section 3. This Act shall take effect 90 days after its enactment into law. <u>SYNOPSIS</u>

This bill prohibits the use of electronic communication devices while operating a motor vehicle on the highways of the State of Delaware unless the person engages in the use of hands-free equipment.
