HOUSE BILL NO. 493

AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 21 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO RULES OF THE ROAD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE:

- 1 Section 1. Amend § 4176C(c), Title 21 of the Delaware Code by adding a new paragraph (8) to read as follows:
- 2 “(8) A person who during their course of employment with a business or government entity uses a two-
- 3 way radio mounted or attached to a motor vehicle to communicate with a central dispatch, base of operation, or
- 4 with other employees of such business or government entity.”.

SYNOPSIS

This bill exempts a person using a two-way communication device mounted or attached to a motor vehicle during their course of employment with a business or government entity while talking to a central dispatch, base of operation, or with other employees of such business or government entity.
