

## 151st GENERAL ASSEMBLY FISCAL NOTE

BILL: HOUSE SUBSTITUTE NO. 1 FOR HOUSE BILL 204

SPONSOR: Representative K. Williams

DESCRIPTION: AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 31 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO

BACKGROUND CHECKS AND SUBSEQUENT CRIMINAL HISTORIES FOR POTENTIAL OR CURRENT EMPLOYEES OF CHILD SERVING ENTITIES.

## **Assumptions:**

1. This Act becomes effective upon signature by the Governor. Upon signature, this Act takes effect 180 days after its enactment.

- 2. This Act authorizes the Department of Education to pay the costs of background checks for its employees.
- 3. Per, the State Bureau of Identification a state and federal background check costs \$65 per person.
- 4. The Department of Education estimates that 50-60 employees would be eligible annually to have their background checks paid for by the Department.
