DESCRIPTION: AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 7 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO

HUNTING.

## **ASSUMPTIONS:**

1. Effective upon signature of the Governor.

- 2. This Act allows for the hunting of deer on private land on Sundays.
- 3. The Department estimates the fiscal impact of this Act will be \$69,310 for the first year and \$61,810 each year thereafter, in order to implement Sunday hunting on private lands. The estimated costs are listed below:
  - The Department estimates that it will require salary costs in the amount of \$54,310 in overtime pay for existing full-time enforcement officers and one part-time reserve officer for five months out of the year (Sundays only).
  - Other costs associated with implementing Sunday hunting consist of contractual services in the amount of \$7,000 to include fleet rental and cell phone usage. A one-time cost of \$7,500 to fully equip one reserve officer within the first year is required.
