SENATE AMENDMENT NO. 2

TO

HOUSE BILL NO. 228

1 AMEND House Bill No. 228 by deleting line 22 and substituting in lieu thereof the following:

2 “for Farmers’ Markets no more than 150 liters of beer, 100 liters of wine and mead, and 50 liters of spirits
3 may be sold per day, and for agricultural-themed events no more than 175 liters of beer, 125 liters of wine
4 and mead, and 75 liters of spirits may be sold”

5 FURTHER AMEND House Bill No. 228 by inserting after line 32 the following:

6 “Section 2. This section shall expire on November 30, 2019. The Office of the Alcoholic Beverage
7 Control Commissioner shall provide the Governor, the President Pro Tempore and the Speaker of the House with a report
8 summarizing the effect of these sales upon the retail market by March 15, 2019.

SYNOPSIS

This amendment reduces the amounts allowed to be sold per day for off-premise consumption. It also sunsets the bill and requires the Commissioner to report on the effect of sales on the retail market.
