

## 151st GENERAL ASSEMBLY FISCAL NOTE

BILL: HOUSE BILL NO. 408

SPONSOR: Representative Chukwuocha

DESCRIPTION: AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 21 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO

INDICATING THE HOLDER IS A VETERAN ON DRIVER LICENSES AND

NONDRIVER IDENTIFICATION CARDS.

## **Assumptions:**

1. This Act becomes effective upon signature of the Governor.

- 2. This Act requires the Delaware Department of Transportation, Division of Motor Vehicles (DMV), upon submission of satisfactory proof, to place a designation indicating that the holder is a veteran on Delaware Driver Licenses or Identification Cards at the time of initial application, renewal, or request for a duplicate.
- 3. To implement the provisions of this Act, the DMV anticipates system programming necessary to allow for this designation estimated at \$20,000.
- 4. This Act will result in additional revenue by introducing a fee for veterans that request the designation before license or identification card renewal. The accompanying Fee Impact Statement for this Act notes indeterminable revenue to the Transportation Trust Fund.
