**BILL:** HOUSE BILL NO. 379  
**SPONSOR:** Representative Dukes  
**DESCRIPTION:** AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 10 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO THE JUVENILE OFFENDER CIVIL CITATION PROGRAM AND EXPUNGEMENT OF A JUVENILE'S RECORD.

---

**Assumptions:**

1. This Act becomes effective 90 days upon signature by the Governor.
2. This Act would allow for automatic expungement for juveniles with a record of a civil citation who choose to participate in the Juvenile Offender Civil Citation Program (JOCCP) one year after completing the JOCCP.
3. This Act would require the Delaware Criminal Justice Information System (DELJIS) to make programming and notification enhancements to the Criminal Justice Information System (CJIS) to ensure that CJIS captures a juvenile's completion of the JOCCP and checks for the timeframe requirement for expungement. DELJIS anticipates it would need specialized contractual programmers to complete this programming update and estimates this to be a one-time cost of \$21,850.
