<b>DESCRIPTION:</b>	<b>AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 21 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO INDICATING THE HOLDER IS A VETERAN ON DRIVER LICENSES AND NONDRIVER IDENTIFICATION CARDS.</b>

*In accordance with 29 Del. C. §913, the following information is provided relating to licenses and fees.*

**Description of the Legislation:**

This Act allows the Delaware Department of Transportation, Division of Motor Vehicles (DMV), upon request, to place a designation indicating that the holder is a veteran on Delaware Driver Licenses or Identification Cards (ID).

**Affected Entities:**

Division of Motor Vehicles, within the Delaware Department of Transportation.

**Fiscal Impact:**

Of the approximately 65,000 veterans residing in Delaware, DMV cannot estimate how many veterans will request the designation outside of the renewal period. Revenues generated from the \$10 fee that is assessed when a licensee or ID holder requests a designation before renewal are indeterminable.

**Intended Use of Revenue:**

Revenues generated will be deposited into the Transportation Trust Fund to support DMV operations.
