<b>DESCRIPTION:</b>	<b>AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 24 AND TITLE 29 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO ELEVATOR MECHANICS.</b>

*In accordance with 29 Del. C. §913, the following information is provided relating to licenses and fees.*

**Description of the Legislation:**

This Act establishes a new chapter in Title 24 for the profession of Elevator Mechanic. This Act creates a State Board of Elevator Mechanics that will establish standards of for licensure as a master elevator mechanic and journeyman elevator mechanic. This Act takes effect upon notice by the Division of Professional Regulation, within the Department of State, that final rules and regulations promulgated by the Board of Elevator Mechanics are complete.

**Affected Entities:**

The Division of Professional Regulation estimates there are approximately 300 licensed master electrician licensees with a specialty in elevators. They are currently licensed by the Board of Electrical Examiners. These individuals will be grandfathered into a Master Elevator Mechanic.

**Fiscal Impact:**

The projected biennial fee is \$200. Based on the number of potential licensees, the total estimated revenue \$60,000.

**Intended Use of Revenue:**

Fee revenue will be used to defray expenses of the Board of Elevator Mechanics as well as proportional expenses incurred by the Division of Professional Regulation in providing service to the Board.
