SPONSOR: Senator Sokola

DESCRIPTION: AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 11 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO DEADLY

WEAPONS.

Assumptions:

1. This Act, known as the Delaware Large Capacity Magazine Prohibition Act of 2022, becomes effective 60 days upon signature by the Governor.

- 2. This Act would require a resident of this State who possesses a large-capacity magazine, no later than June 30, 2023, to relinquish the large-capacity magazine to a law enforcement agency of this State.
- 3. Further, this Act requires the Secretary of the Department of Safety and Homeland Security to establish and administer a compensation program for residents of this State who relinquish a large-capacity magazine in exchange for \$10 for each large-capacity magazine.
- 4. Lastly, this Act subjects the compensation program to the availability of funds appropriated for this specific purchase by the General Assembly and appropriates \$45,000 from the General Fund for Fiscal Year 2022. The compensation program provision of this Act expires on January 1, 2023.
