I	AMEND Senate Substitute No. 1 for Senate Bill No. 6 as amended by Senate Amendment No. 1, House Amendment
2	No. 1, and House Amendment No. 2 on line 15 by deleting "subsections (c) and (d)" before "of" therein and inserting in lieu
3	thereof " <u>subsections (c) through (e)</u> ".
4	FURTHER AMEND Senate Substitute No. 1 for Senate Bill No. 6 as amended by Senate Amendment No. 1, House
5	Amendment No. 1, and House Amendment No. 2 by inserting the following after line 49 and before line 50:
6	"(e) This section does not apply to any of the following:
7	(1) A person who manufactures a large-capacity magazine, if the person manufactures the large-capacity
8	magazine with the intent to sell the large-capacity magazine, or offer the large-capacity magazine for sale, to a person
9	outside of this State.
10	(2) A person who ships or transports a large-capacity magazine for a person under paragraph (e)(1) of this
11	section.".

<u>SYNOPSIS</u>

Currently, there is a manufacturer of firearm magazines in Georgetown that employs nearly 90 workers and produces 30, 20, 15, and 10 round magazines.

This Amendment excludes a person who manufactures a large-capacity magazine from the application of the law if the person manufactures the large-capacity magazine with the intent to sell the large-capacity magazine, or offer the largecapacity magazine for sale, to a person outside of this State. The Amendment also excludes a person who ships or transports the large-capacity magazine for a person who manufactures a large-capacity magazine for sale to a person outside of this State.
