AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 29 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO THE OFFICE OF NEW AMERICANS.

Assumptions:

- 1. This Act is effective upon the signature of the Governor.
- 2. This Act establishes the "Office of New Americans" ("Office") within the Department of State. The Office is tasked with various responsibilities including:
 - a. Respond to inquiries about immigration issues in the State.
 - b. Serve as an information clearinghouse for immigration-related policy issues.
 - c. Analyze economic, demographic and other trends impacting immigrants.
 - d. Convene various stakeholders in business, government, immigrant-service organization and academia on subjects related to immigrants and immigration.
 - e. Disseminate information to various stakeholders.
 - f. Communicate with federal and international stakeholders to support the resettlement process for refugees.
 - g. Work with the Advisory Committee established by this Act.
- 3. Upon enactment, annual funding for the Office, commencing in Fiscal Year 2024 is estimated as follows:
 - a. A total of \$543,620 which includes:
 - i. \$337,220 Personnel Costs, including other employment costs, for 4.0 FTEs, including 1.0 Director, 1.0 Community Relations Coordinator, 1.0 Human Relations Representative, and 1.0 Administrative Specialist.
 - ii. \$206,400 Operating Costs (travel, supplies & materials, rent, marketing, translation services, temporary staffing, capital outlay).
- 4. Future year personnel costs are assumed to increase at a rate of 2% annually.
