

152nd GENERAL ASSEMBLY FISCAL NOTE

BILL: HOUSE BILL NO. 244

SPONSOR: Representative Michael Smith

DESCRIPTION: AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 14 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO

FUNDING FOR ATHLETIC TRAINERS.

Assumptions:

1. This Act becomes effective upon signature by the Governor.

- 2. This Act creates Athletic Trainer Units of funding for school districts and charter schools. One (1) Athletic Trainer Unit shall be allocated for every school that serves grades 9-12.
- 3. Per the September 30, 2022, Unit Count, there are approximately 59 schools that serve grades 9-12. Upon implementation, this Act will generate an estimated 59 units of funding for full-time Athletic Trainers.
- 4. Funding for an Athletic Trainer shall be shared between State and Local funds based upon the 14 Del. Code § 1305 school employee salary schedule. A school or district may choose to provide all or part of the services of an Athletic Trainer through a contract with a public or private agency.
- 5. The average state unit of funding for an Athletic Trainer is estimated to be \$74,829, while the local share of personnel costs is estimated at \$24,552. Other employment costs are assumed at a rate of 32.25%.
- 6. Overall costs are assumed to increase at an annual rate of 2.0%.
