

## 152nd GENERAL ASSEMBLY FISCAL NOTE

BILL: HOUSE BILL NO. 103

SPONSOR: Representative Bush

DESCRIPTION: AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 17 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO TRAFFIC

IMPACTS OF DEVELOPMENT.

## **Assumptions:**

1. This Act becomes effective upon signature of the Governor.

- 2. This Act requires the Department of Transportation (DelDOT) to establish a transportation impact fee to apply within areas of the state designated in the Delaware Strategies for State Policies and Spending as an investment level 1 or 2 area and that are not located within an established local or regional transportation improvement district.
- 3. This Act expands upon the duties of DelDOT for the development and modeling of square miles within levels 1 and 2. DelDOT anticipates the need for additional personnel to implement the provisions of this Act.
- 4. Recurring annual personnel costs to DelDOT are estimated at \$253,432 as follows:
  - a. \$253,432 in personnel costs, including Other Employment Costs (OECs) at a rate of 32.25%, for 1.0 FTE, Engineering Program Manager, and 1.0 FTE, Engineer IV.
- 5. Additionally, a 2% inflation cost is included for projected salary increases, health insurance, and OECs in future years.
