

152nd GENERAL ASSEMBLY FISCAL NOTE

BILL: HOUSE BILL NO. 292

SPONSOR: Representative Morrison

DESCRIPTION: AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 15 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO REVIEW

OF CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS AND EXPENDITURES.

Assumptions:

1. This Act becomes effective upon the signature of the Governor.

- 2. This Act requires the Department of Elections (Department) to:
 - a. Within 60 days of filing, review all candidates' political committee contribution and expense reports for any contribution or expense violation.
 - b. Note the report on the Department's website as either "submitted but not reviewed" or "reviewed and final."
- 3. This Act applies to all contribution and expense reports submitted after February 1, 2025.
- 4. To implement the provisions of this Act, the Department anticipates the need for additional staff to complete the requirements. Recurring costs are estimated at \$130,268, and one-time costs are estimated at \$14,000 and are as follows:
 - a. Recurring Costs: \$130,268
 - i. \$127,568 in the Fiscal Year 2025 Personnel Costs, including Other Employment Costs (OECs) at a rate of 32.25%, for 2.0 FTE Administrative Specialist II positions.
 - ii. \$2,700 for ongoing supplies, telephone, and software needs.
 - b. One-Time Costs \$14,000
 - i. One-time costs of \$14,000 for computer equipment, office cubicles, and furniture startup costs for new positions.
- Fiscal Year 2025 personnel costs have been estimated for six months of funding, with the
 annualization of the remaining six months incorporated into subsequent year estimates.
 Additionally, a 2% inflation cost has been included for project increases in salary, health insurance,
 and OECs annually.
