<b>DESCRIPTION:</b>	<b>AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 7 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO TROTLINE LICENSES.</b>

*In accordance with 29 Del. C. §913, the following information is provided relating to licenses and fees.*

**Description of the Legislation:**

This Act creates a new license for trotlines in commercial crabbing and takes effect on January 1 following its enactment into law.

**Affected Entities:**

Affected entities of this legislation are commercial crabbers and the Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control (DNREC).

**Fiscal Impact:**

- This Act directs DNREC to offer annual trotline crab licenses at \$57.50 for residents and \$575 for non-residents.
- This Act permits commercial crabbers to possess either the current crab pot license or the new crab trotline license.
- There are currently 240 active commercial crab pot licenses. However, the total number of licenses is limited per Title 7, Chapter 29, §1918(a) to a maximum of 100 total crab pot and trotline licenses to be held.
- Commercial crab fishing licenses can be transferred at any time, including posthumously to immediate family; and at any time to another person who is eligible to receive the license.

Per DNREC, it is anticipated that the addition of trotline licenses would most likely result in a loss of revenue due to some existing license holders switching from crab pot licenses to trotline licenses.

**Intended Use of Revenue:**

Revenues generated are intended to support the administrative costs of the DNREC Division of Fish and Wildlife.
