

152nd GENERAL ASSEMBLY FISCAL NOTE

BILL: HOUSE BILL NO. 342

SPONSOR: Representative Morrison

DESCRIPTION: AN ACT TO AMEND TITLES 11 AND 24 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO

THE VOLUNTARY FIREARMS DO-NOT-SELL REGISTRY ACT.

Assumptions:

1. This Act becomes effective upon signature by the Governor and is to be implemented on or before January 1, 2025.

- 2. This Act requires the Superintendent of the Delaware State Police to create a Voluntary Firearms Do-Not-Sell Registry in which an applicant may voluntarily enroll to be prohibited from obtaining a firearm. The Act requires the Superintendent to develop a process and forms for inclusion on and removal from a Voluntary Firearms Do-Not-Sell Registry. An applicant shall deliver a completed form in person to any law enforcement agency within the State.
- 3. This Act would necessitate the Delaware Criminal Justice Information System (DELJIS) to enhance the functionality of the Criminal Justice Information System (CJIS) to accommodate the creation of a web-based form through the Law Enforcement Investigate Support System (LEISS) to provide entry for all law enforcement agencies statewide.
- 4. DELJIS estimates that it would require one-time funding of \$90,000 to create and integrate the various functionalities into CJIS, as called for in this Act.
