DESCRIPTION: AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 29 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO THE LOTTERY.

In accordance with 29 Del. C. §913, the following information is provided relating to licenses and fees.

Description of the Legislation:

This Act establishes competitive mobile sports wagering. Under this Act, the Lottery Director is authorized to establish regulations governing competitive mobile sports wagering. Each video lottery agent is authorized to contract with up to two internet sports lottery operators awarded licenses by the Lottery Director. No licensed internet sports lottery operator may establish a contractual arrangement with more than one video lottery agent.

Affected Entities:

Internet sports lottery operators.

Fiscal Impact:

Licensed internet sports lottery operators are required to pay a \$500,000 licensing fee for an initial five-year term. Subsequent five-year renewal fees are \$250,000. The Act authorizes up to six licensed internet sports lottery operators (the three video lottery agents: Delaware Park, Harrington, and Bally's Dover, are authorized to contract with up to two internet sports lottery operators each).

Intended Use of Revenue:

Revenue realized through the licensing fees is to be deposited to the General Fund.
