



**152nd GENERAL ASSEMBLY  
FISCAL NOTE**

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**BILL:** HOUSE BILL NO. 434  
**SPONSOR:** Representative Collins  
**DESCRIPTION:** AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 7 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL AND TRANSPARENCY IN PUBLIC HEARINGS.

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**Assumptions:**

1. This Act is effective upon signature of the Governor.
2. This Act requires the Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control (DNREC) to hold public hearings with the following requirements:
  - a. Allow for public in-person attendance and the opportunity to testify.
  - b. Allow the public to virtually attend and testify in addition to in-person attendance and testimony.
  - c. Allow all who wish to testify the opportunity to sign up at and during the public hearing.
  - d. Provide proper notice and schedule for no less than 2 hours of testimony.
  - e. Provide no limit to testimony unless the hearing officer determines that the number of persons wishing to testify is significant and necessitates a time limit with no person being limited to less than one minute of public testimony.
3. This Act expands upon the duties of DNREC by adding an in-person opportunity and additional requirements that expand hearing times for approximately 20 hearings per year. To implement the provisions of this Act, DNREC anticipates the need for the following:
  - a. Recurring Costs: \$200,576
    - i. Required overtime for DNREC staff for expanded hearing requirements of \$142,611 in Fiscal Year 2025 for 4 staff and 2 Natural Resource Police Officers including Other Employment Costs (OECs).
    - ii. \$57,965 Contractual costs for fleet vehicle, court reporter expenses, facility rental, and on-site technology support.
4. Future year personnel costs are assumed to increase at a rate of 2%.
